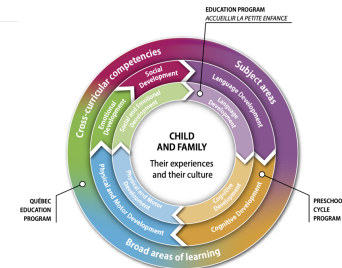


At Lennoxville Elementary, our preschool program is dedicated to nurturing the whole child by supporting growth in all areas: physical, motor, emotional, social, language, and cognitive development. We believe that every aspect of a child's development is equally important and that these areas grow best when nurtured together in harmony.

Each day, our students participate in activities thoughtfully designed to match their individual abilities, needs, interests, and cultural backgrounds. These experiences help children learn within their zone of *proximal development* — the area between what they can do on their own and what they can achieve with guidance from adults or peers. This approach, detailed in the Québec Education Program (QEP), encourages children to reach their full potential through collaboration and support.



Our program embraces child-led learning by:

- Offering countless ways for children to express themselves creatively and authentically
- Giving children some control over their learning journey through play and exploration
- Providing rich, hands-on experiences involving movement, listening, touching, and observing
- Encouraging meaningful relationships with peers and the environment as they discover the world around them
- Creating inviting indoor and outdoor spaces filled with open-ended materials that spark investigation, imagination, problem-solving, and creativity
- Introducing STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, mathematics) concepts through playful provocations, storytelling, and exploration
- Building early literacy skills through dynamic storytelling ecosystems (see below) designed to inspire and engage
